



SLT Meeting Minutes May 18, 2017

In Attendance: Keisha Warner, Alison Beckman, Derrick Cameron, Aida Cruz, Cierra Seda, Jessica Peavy **Tentative CEP Goals 2016-2017**

By June 28, 2017:

- the Math department will collaborative develop a rubric to improve the articulation of students' approach to multi-step, real-world problems as measured by a 5% increase in scores of 75 or higher on the Regents.
- 100% of Cinema School teachers will have participated in a collaborative planning for school culture events.
- a minimum of 100% of the teaching staff will have participated in voluntary professional development (attended, planned or facilitated) that supports rigorous instruction.
- at least 75% of the teaching staff will have an overall Measures of Teacher Practice (MOTP) score of 2.75 or above in components 3b and 3c of the Danielson rubric.
- the majority of our parents will access information about their child's progress in school as evidenced by a minimum of 66% who log into Pupil Path.

II- CEP Goals Check-In and Related Business (5:10pm)

- Quality Review
 - Happened on May 16 and 17
 - Consisted of 4 teacher team discussions and 10 classroom visits
 - 1 teacher team was a SIT team for Special Education, 1 teacher team was an ADI presentation and 2 teacher team discussions were Q & A, in which Mr. Linville was present for, as required as UFT rep.
 - Met with 6 students to discuss work that they were proud of and struggled on
 - Met with 6 students for a Q & A
 - Culminating Feedback Session on May 18. I'm not going to communicate with the staff what the ratings were. I will discuss with the administrative team about what we will do go forward. There are some suggestions
 - We moved Curriculum from Developing to Proficient
 - We are touching on Well-Developed in some areas – for example, College and Career Readiness (indicator 3.4)
 - Appealing to reviewer to receive a Well-Developed in the positive learning environment.
- Admin picks some of the students and the Quality Review person selects some of the rest

Mr. Linville passed out problems in which students had to solve a quadratic equation and write an explanation. The students were graded on a writing rubric



- Ms. Warner would like to push towards less reading out loud in class. This is a waste of instructional time, though this is reliant on students being independent and we need to push them in this direction
- Positive school culture events: Quiz Bowl next week planned by 9th Grade Team, Moving Up Ceremony for the 11th grade (put together by 10th grade team), some seniors will be addressing some of the 10th graders.
- There is a PowerPoint about the SAT. Students will all take an oath. Teachers will acknowledge most successful as well as the most improved students. Tuesday afternoon.
- 11th Grade team – College Panel Wednesday next week
- 12th Grade team – College & Career Fair on Thursday – a variety of jobs will be there.
- Monday will be a Senior Breakfast 1st and 2nd period in which students announce the colleges that they were selected for.

- Talent Show was successful
- Make me think about having some more variety in our afterschool programs, like vocal training or yoga

Goal:

-At least 75% of the teaching staff will have MOTP score of 2.75 or above in components 3b and 3c of the Danielson Rubric

- We looked at the Quality Review Rubric 1.2 and 3c Engaging Students in Learning. One of the feedbacks is around Rigor. This is something that was noticed in the classroom. In many classrooms, there were problems with Rigor.

-The last bullet is about 66% of parents logging on to Pupil Path has not been reached

Cierra is noticing that she cannot see any grades for some of her classes. It is hard to see what is happening.

-There will be initiatives for next year to improve parent participation.
